

Preparation Sheet for Control of Fleas

Pick up EVERYTHING from all floors and carpets including under the bed and closet: Toys, shoes, clothes, pillows, magazines, plants, etc. EVERYTHING SHOULD BE UP OFF THE FLOOR **EXCEPT THE FURNITURE**

- 1. Vacuum all areas of the entire house and throw away the vacuum bag outside. Place a new bag after treatment. If you have a bag-less vacuum cleaner you need to empty the canister in the garbage outside. Vacuuming them up inside your house is counterproductive if you're going to release them into your yard or garage when you dump the vacuum canister!
- 2. All pet bedding must be washed in hot water to kill the fleas prior to treatment, preferably on the day of treatment.
- 3. Pets must be professionally treated (by Vet or Groomer) for fleas on the day of treatment. PETS CANNOT REMAIN IN YOUR HOME DURING TREATMENT. **REMOVE PET BOWLS AND TOYS.**
- 4. Everyone must be out of the house for 4 hours until the surfaces have dried
- 5. VERY IMPORTANT: Vacuum at least once a day for 7 days after the treatment.
- 6. If your lawn is tall, please cut grass prior to treatment.
- 7. If in a week you are still experiencing flea activity, call us we will come back out to treat again. This is a second hatch (eggs that hatch after treatment; which can happen with bad infestations)
